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A story made of authenticity and urban attitude

Between **Santos** and **Cais do Sodré**, close to the recently refurbished Time Out Market, **Ribeira 11** is located in a former industrial area surrounded by historical, cultural and social amenities. Santos neighborhood was named in 2005 as **Santos Design District**, having sheltered designers, architects and art enthusiasts ever since.

Cais do Sodré's proximity to Tagus River made this area sought after for sailors and travelers, who explored this neighborhood's bohemian spirit and eclecticism, traits that can still be found today. Therefore, Cais do Sodré is one of the Lisbon's most trending nightlife areas, with popular bars, restaurants and nightclubs.



A story made of authenticity and urban attitude

In **Cais do Sodré** we can find schools and art studios working next to bustling restaurants; old tile façades and charming old buildings surrounded by modern construction.

The recently refurbished Time Out Market is seen as a landmark for this area of the city.

The building is part of an area covered by the **Plano de Pormenor do Aterro da Boavista Nascente**, an intervention plan to develop this riverside area. Public gardens in the building surroundings will be created, through the demolition of existing buildings in the Boqueirão dos Ferreiros street, as well as the transformation of constructions in the **Ribeira 11** rear façade into a vertical garden.




A XIX century history.

In the Santos district, between 1858 and 1859 narrow roads were born, linking Rua da Boavista and other main streets to Tagus River. **Boqueirão dos Ferreiros**, where **Ribeira 11** building is located, is one of those roads, full of industrial buildings.

The existing building was constructed in the XX century and its aesthetic was thought and developed with the main purpose of serving, firstly as a metalworking warehouse and then as a cardboard warehouse. This link with industrial activities led to the choice of industrial related materials as the concrete and lime, as well as its construction system based on structural stone masonry and partition walls in the upper floors.



A XIX century history.



The architecture solution searches a harmonious structural logic between the original building and the new building, creating a light outer structure, contrasting to the original heavy structure.

With the rehabilitation works, **Ribeira 11** intends to remain a **reference**in this riverside area as one of the examples of a past made of a
pragmatic architecture and related to this area's industrial characteristics.

The wide common terrace in the south end of the building creates an exclusive and quiet area for **Ribeira 11** residents, who can also enjoy an outdoor training area in its rooftop.



A story made of contrasts.

Ribeira 11 comprises **37 unique apartments** with its contemporary aesthetics aligned with the choice for sturdy yet comforting finishes. The apartments range between **TO** (zero-bedroom) **to T3** (three-bedroom) **and Lofts**, distributed over four floors. The interiors sophistication along with the pure architecture result in a residential project that combines authenticity and curiosity.

The riverside location makes **Ribeira 11** the ideal choice for those who want to be part of a recently renovated area and start a new life in a highly sought after Lisbon's neighborhood.








The architecture project belongs to Ricardo Carvalho + Joana Vilhena studio

Ricardo Carvalho + Joana Vilhena Architects is a Lisbon based office responsible for both private and public buildings such as an hotel, schools, apartment buildings, exhibition design and a museum. Their work has been featured in several international magazines and has been presented in lectures in **Europe**, **Canada**, **China**, **Japan**, **Israel** and **Latin America**.

Six Portuguese Architecture Studios" in the Royal Institute of British Architects in London (2009); "Portugal Convida" in the FAD, Barcelona (2010); "Tradition is Innovation" in Ozone Design Center in Tokyo (2011); "Lisbon Ground" in the Venice Architecture Biennale (2012) and "A Room for Mexico City" in Liga, Mexico City (2013). In 2015 they were nominated for the Mies van der Rohe European Architecture Prize.
